

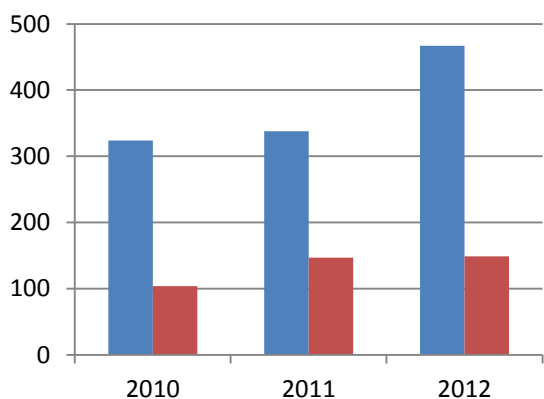

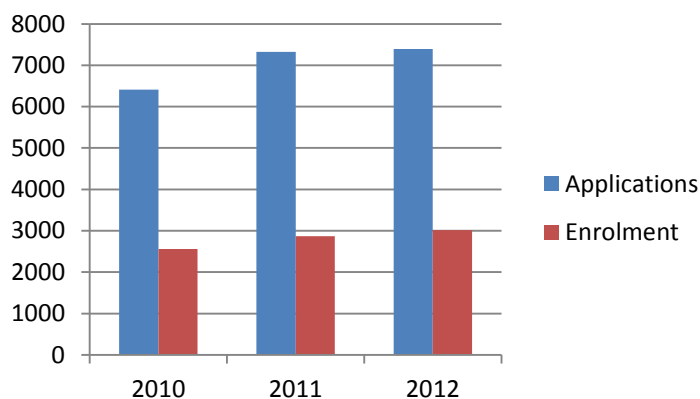

Description

- Data is collected by the Faculty of Graduate Studies every year: Admission data (applications) are collected by March 1 of each year, and it represents full applications only; Enrolment data are collected by November of that same year.
- Percentages are calculated based on the sum total of both domestic and international applications/enrolment at each campus.
- The number represents total head count, not full-time equivalents (FTEs), for UBC Okanagan and Vancouver combined.

Data collection will be from: Dean, Faculty of Graduate Studies.

Date: Applications: March 1, every year. Enrolment: November 1, every year.

Explanation of Results

2% increase in total # of international graduate students applications in 2012 (7863), in comparison to 2011 (7663).

1% increase of total # of international graduate students enrolled in 2012 (3166), in comparison to 2011 (3016).
