Description

Graduation rate

- Based on students registered 1 November
- CSRDE Standard (students who were first-entry, first-year, and full-time in their first year)
- Year shown is the year students first registered at UBC
- Rates include entire calendar year (i.e. a 2001/2 entry would graduate within 7 years if graduating any time within 2008)
- Okanagan has only 1 year's data as it opened in 2005

Time to Completion

- Average number of years from first registration at UBC to convocation year (e.g. student beginning Sept 2008 and graduating in 2012 would have a time to completion of 4 years)
- Includes transfer students and students who were not continuously enrolled
- Baccalaureate students only
- Okanagan data not yet available as many transferred from Okanagan College so there is missing data

 Data collection will be from: PAIR UBC retention data set, sql against SIS: SRRR_DEGREET (graduation rate)
 Sql against SIS: SRRR_DEGREET and SRRR_SESS_ENRLT
 Date: Winter session as of 1 November (cohort selection), calendar year for matching graduation data

Explanation of Results

The data presented is as expected and continues to benchmark positively to peer institutions.

Recommended Action

Graduation rates for International Students are lower than desired. Recent research at UBC has shown that pre-entry preparation programs are successful and should therefore be further refined and expanded.
