

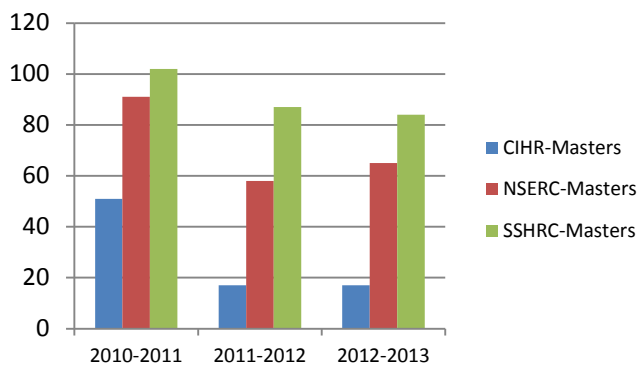

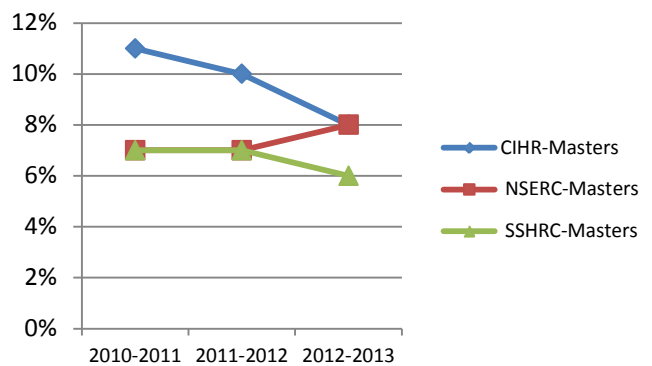

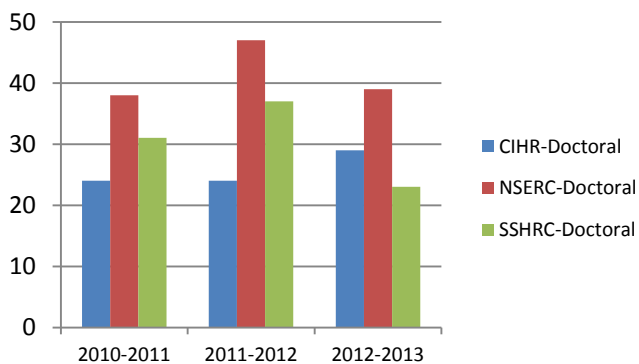
3-Year Trend of number of UBC Awarded CGS Masters Scholarships

#### Description

- Internal review process selects top candidates from the total applicants' pool and forwards to Ottawa.



- The data is a combination of FoGS' own awards records (Paid to UBC students) and Tri-Agency records from their respective websites (Total Offered).
- The number of offers made from competition to competition can vary significantly (unlike in the Vanier competition, where the number of offers falls within a very narrow band of ~54-57 per agency per competition). Therefore, FoGS tracks results by share of total awards offered, rather than success rate of applications forwarded to Ottawa.
